Plans are coming along for an all-church survey to be conducted March 9 – 25. You will receive an email link to access the survey during that time. Accommodations will be made for those who don't use computers. Vital Church Ministries is the survey company we are using; a much respected Christian organization with a lot of experience doing surveys and coaching leadership. The survey is being individualized for our church, so it should give us very helpful information.

The purposes of the survey are to:

1. *Give a current snapshot of our congregation– Who are we and where is God leading us?*
2. *Analyze our strengths and weaknesses*
3. *Inform the search team of qualities desired in our next pastor*

The survey will take about 30 minutes to complete. It really does matter that everyone participates. We would love a full and descriptive picture of our current membership and regular attenders! A detailed demographic survey of our community will be also done in March, using the Percept Group. All this information will be used by the Elders, Search Team and Transition Team to chart a wise course moving ahead.

A recommendation was made to Session to immediately begin the process of selecting a Search Team for the Senior Pastor search. More details on this can be found in the Session minutes and upcoming Connects.

A recommendation was made to Session that we reintroduce the “Rescued, Restored, Released” Vision Statement (that was operational until a few years ago) as Cornerstone’s current Vision Statement. This vision was sidetracked the past 2 years but remains very much a part of our” DNA”. We need to reintroduce it at this time because the survey will ask us to respond to the vision of our church. While this is not ideal, the Transition Team feels the “3R’s” is the mostly widely accepted and understood vision statement that we have at this time.
