

Men's Buckskin Slot Canyon Trip

May 19 – 22, 2020

Four-day trip to hike and explore the world renowned Buckskin Gulch (slot canyon) in lower Utah. We were able to secure a highly coveted permit (competing with people from around the world) to backpack overnight (limit 10 people) along the Buckskin Gulch trail the night of May 20. Length of hike approximately 8.5 miles.

We will exit Buckskin Gulch the following day (May 21) via Wire Pass Slot Canyon and drive to Capital Reef via scenic Highway 12 late afternoon to spend the night at Capital Reef. The next morning (May 22) we will hike up to Cassidy Arch and thereafter continue our trip home.

We will leave Greeley early morning Tuesday, May 19 and drive to Kanab, UT (665 miles, 12.5 hours) and return Friday, May 22.



Everyone is required to bring their own bedding, cooking utensils and food (weight & amount is critical but should be adequate for inclement weather). Backpack tents usually sleep 2 so number of tents will depend on the number of participants.

Several vehicles will be driving—leaving Tue morning. If not traveling in your own vehicle the cost will be around \$175 per person if we sleep 2 to a hotel room (2 nights) not including your meals.
